Weill Cornell Medicine Department of Psychiatry at New York-Presbyterian is pleased to announce that it is accepting applications for the 2018 Diversity Visiting Sub-Internship Program. The program is open to fourth year medical student applicants from groups underrepresented in medicine including Black/African American, American Indian, Alaska Native, Hispanic and Pacific Islander. The accepted student will be provided with housing and a \$1500 stipend for travel and living expenses during the month-long visit. One sub-internship is available only for the month of **July 2018**.

Program Description

The student will work closely with the clinical team on a selected psychiatry service. Students will have the opportunity to meet with an advisor and attend PGY 2 or PGY 3 resident didactic classes in addition to clinical learning. We hope to offer the student a chance to experience the Department of Psychiatry and its residents with an eye toward future training opportunities at Weill Cornell-New York Presbyterian.

Eligibility

- Fourth year medical student applicants from groups underrepresented in medicine.
- Must be a registered full time 4th year medical student at an LCME accredited U.S. medical school.
- Must have demonstrated vision and commitment to excellence and have an interest in advancing diversity within the specialty.

Requirements for Participation

- Completed and signed program application [page 2]
- Official transcript
- Brief personal statement describing career goals and interest in pursuing Sub-Internship at WCM-NYP
- Copy of Curriculum Vitae
- Letter of support from a student affairs dean sent directly to Rebecca Hellman.

Application Deadline is April 15, 2018.
