



Diversity Visiting Student Acting Internship Program











Intern at Weill Cornell Medicine, Department of Radiology

Students will be assigned to divisions, including: ED/ Musculoskeletal, Chest, Body US/CT, Neuroradiology, Women's Imaging, Interventional Radiology, and Pediatric Radiology. Additional rotations may be scheduled based on the student's preference. Students are expected to attend all simulation, teaching, and conferences with the house staff. Students will be assigned a resident and faculty mentor during their time in the department.

Program Description

The Diversity Visiting Student Internship Program in Radiology is a four week funded advanced elective for fourth year medical students interested in Radiology. The program gives students who are traditionally underrepresented in radiology the opportunity to rotate at NewYork-Presbyterian, Weill Cornell Department of Radiology.

Who Should Apply?

This program is open to all applicants who belong to groups recognized as historically underrepresented in the health profession including: African American, American Indian, Alaska Native, Hispanic American, and Pacific Islander. This advanced elective is four weeks in duration and is available to students who meet the requirements of Weill Cornell Medical College Application Requirements: Please submit two letters of recommendation, curriculum vitae, and brief personal statement to Kemi Babagbemi, MD at keb2012@med.cornell.edu. All applicants also are required to apply via VSAS (Visiting Student Application Service of the AAMC).
